



Average Number Federal Health Citations per Recertification Survey 1/1/19 - 9/30/19






Percentage of Facilities with Citations at Harm and/or Immediate Jeopardy 1/1/19 - 9/30/19







Percentage of Facilities with Substandard Quality of Care 1/1/19 - 9/30/19




Immediate Jeopardy Citations 2005 - 10/9/2019








Average Number Federal Health Citations per Recertification Survey First Three Quarters 2019






Percentage of Recertification Surveys with Harm or Jeopardy Citations First Three Quarters 2019






Percentage of Recertification Surveys with Substandard Quality of Care First Three Quarters 2019






Average Number Federal Health Citations per Complaint Survey First Three Quarters 2019






Percentage of Complaint Surveys with Harm or Jeopardy Citations First Three Quarters 2019
