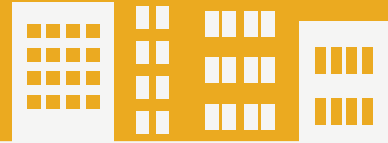


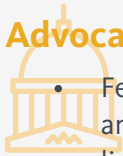
ASSISTED LIVING

Advocacy



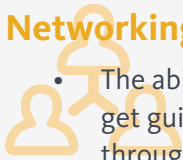
- Federal advocacy and monitoring of state and federal regulations pertaining to assisted living.

Education/Professional Development



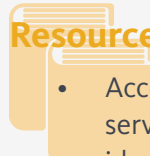
- Access to the latest news in the field and in the life plan/assisted living line of service through the *Life Plan/Assisted Living Report Newsletter*.
