Job Summary: Under the supervision of the Director of Nursing, the Case Manager/Infection Control Nurse is responsible for the ongoing development, coordination, and monitoring of the facility’s health promotion and infection prevention and control program (IPCP) for sister residents and employees. Ensures compliance of these programs with all related governing regulations. Leads and participates in clinical quality improvement projects and activities. The IPCP is designed to provide a safe, sanitary, and comfortable environment and to help prevent the development and transmission of communicable diseases and infections. The Case Manager/Infection Control Nurse oversees the licensed nursing staff and the sister residents plan of care and assists in the training and development activities for nursing staff of the organization in collaboration with the Director of Nursing, Human Resources Director, and other Department Managers of the organization.
