

F 329 Unnecessary Drugs

- Each residents' medication regimen must be free of unnecessary drugs
- Residents who have not used antipsychotic drugs are not given these unless needed to treat a specific condition and,
- Residents who use antipsychotics receive GDRs and behavioral interventions unless clinically contraindicated



F 329 Unnecessary Drugs

- Surveyors investigate medication management principals and pharmaceutical care procedures are in place and implemented
- Evaluate communication amongst providers
- Surveyors are not practicing medicine






