Due to the number of current registrants and training enrollees:

- Registration closed 7/31/2019
- Training enrollment closed 8/15/2019

Participants

- 13 technical colleges with approved nurse aide training programs (NATPs)
- 10 private NATPs
- 17 nursing homes with NATPs
- 310 nursing home participants

As of November 30, 2019 there are:

- 9,010 registered for WisCaregiver Careers
- 3,212 students enrolled in training
- 2,171 successfully completed training
- 1,995 completed testing
- 770 employed at WI nursing home
- 872 successfully tested but not employed*

* This is according to our reports however, the majority of these are employed but no employment record has been entered into the tracking system.

- August 2019 DHS request to CMS to extend WisCaregiver Careers. CMS denied request.
- September November DHS appealed, provided additional information. CMS final ruling - CMP funding can not pay for training or testing.

- DHS continues to explore ways to extend the program.





WisCaregiver Careers: Adding 3,000 Nursing Home Caregivers





WisCaregiver Careers started with free nurse aide training and testing for caring individuals not currently listed on the Wisconsin Nurse Aide Registry. After successfully completing training and testing, participants apply for a job with a participating nursing home, and receive a \$500 retention bonus after six months of work. Those WisCaregiver nursing homes are listed below. Those in training programs now, or who have just completed a training program, can use the map or tables to contact a participating nursing home about employment. This was previously Step 3 in the process.

In an effort to attract and retain more nursing home caregivers, the Department of Health Services (DHS) launched the innovative WisCaregiver Careers program on March 1, 2018. DHS received federal approval to invest \$2.3 million to implement WisCaregiver Careers, designed to add approximately 3,000 nurse aides to this high-demand field.

As of July 31, 2019, more than 9,000 people have registered for the WisCaregiver Careers program. To date more than 3,000 people have enrolled in training. Due to the number of current registrants and training enrollments, both new registration and training enrollment are closed for WisCaregiver Careers until further notice. We are exploring ways to extend the program and re-

People who are already enrolled in a training program with WisCaregiver Careers can continue with the program as usual. Those in training programs now, or who have just completed a training program can <u>contact a participating nursing home</u> about employment.








WisCaregiver Career Program Report: July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2019 Age Ranges






WisCaregiver Career Program Report: July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2019 **How Participants Heard of the Program**
